LANCOPEX'90 Cachet/Cancellation

Barr's Penny Dispatch was a Local Post established in 1854 by Elias Barr at Lancaster, PA. Local Posts were privately owned enterprises established to deposit and pick up mail at the post office prior to carrier service. Mr. Barr advertised that Barr's Penny Dispatch would deliver mail to or from the post office for a fee of 1¢. He issued stamps that could be purchased at Zahn & Jackson Jewelry Store, 15 N. Queen St. and would pick up mail from boxes he placed within the city.


Two stamps were issued, a common black on green paper and a scarcer red on white paper. In 1935, The Lancaster Stamp Club, the predecessor of the Lancaster County Philatelic Society, issued a souvenir sheet of the green stamp at their fifth exhibition. The red stamp has been reproduced using the same plates for

the fifth anniversary of Lancopex.

The commemorative covers were prepared for Lancopex '90. The identical covers depict the Barr's Penny Dispatch stamp in correct color.

The cancelaation was taken from an actual 1855 postmark of the type in use during the existence of Barr's Penny Dispatch. The "Paid 3" was used when stamps were not available.
