THE PENNSYLVANIA POSTAL HISTORY SOCIETY (PPHS) IS AN EDUCATIONAL ORGANIZATION DEDICATED TO THE STUDY, PRESERVATION, AND PUBLICATION OF MATERIAL RELEVANT TO THE POSTAL HISTORY OF PENNSYLVANIA.

LANCOPEX APPRECIATES THE OPPORTUNITY TO SPONSOR THE PPHS MID-YEAR MEETING. ALL INTERESTED PERSONS ARE INVITED TO ATTEND THE 2 P.M. MEETING ON SATURDAY.

# LEWIS & CLARK-THE LANCASTER CONNECTION

PRESIDENT THOMAS JEFFERSON DISPATCHED HIS FRIEND AND SECRETARY MERIWETHER LEWIS TO SEVERAL EASTERN TOWNS AS A PRELUDE TO WHAT WE NOW KNOW AS THE LEWIS & CLARK EXPEDITION. THE YEAR WAS 1803 AND MR. JEFFERSON HAD RECEIVED APPROVAL FROM CONGRESS TO EXPLORE THE POSSIBILITY OF A ROUTE TO THE PACIFIC OCEAN FOLLOWING THE MISSOURI AND COLUMBIA RIVERS.

MERIWETHER LEWIS ARRIVED IN LANCASTER ON APRIL 19, 1803 TO BE SCHOOLED BY ANDREW ELLICOTT, A SKILLED AND EXPERIENCED SURVEYOR, IN SKILLS NEEDED TO GUIDE AND CHART THE WESTWARD EXPLORATION.

IN MAY 1803, AFTER HIS TRAINING WITH ANDREW ELLICOTT, LEWIS CONTINUED ON TO PHILADELPHIA, HARPERS FERRY AND PITTSBURGH TO OBTAIN EQUIPMENT, SUPPLIES AND ADDITIONAL TRAINING. LEWIS MET HIS PARTNER WILLIAM CLARK IN OCTOBER 1803 IN LOUISVILLE, KENTUCKY. FROM THERE, AFTER LAST MINUTE TRAINING AND PREPARATIONS, THEY STARTED THE ADVENTURE THAT WOULD TAKE THEM TO THE PACIFIC OCEAN IN NOVEMBER 1805. THE SUCCESSFUL RETURN TRIP TO ST. LOUIS WAS COMPLETED ON SEPTEMBER 23,1806.

LANCASTER WILL CELEBRATE THE BICENTENNIAL OF ANDREW ELLICOTT'S PART IN THE LEWIS & CLARK ADVENTURE WITH A SERIES OF EVENTS STARTING ON APRIL 19, 2003. THE FOCUS OF THIS CELEBRATION WILL BE CENTERED AROUND THE ELLICOTT HOMESTEAD WHERE LEWIS STAYED AND RECEIVED HIS TRAINING. THE RESTORED ELLICOTT HOUSE IS NOW THE OFFICES OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION TRUST OF LANCASTER COUNTY AT 123 NORTH PRINCE STREET.

THE LANCASTER COUNTY PHILATELIC SOCIETY WILL COMMEMORATE THE BICENTENNIAL AT LANCOPEX WITH THE ISSUE OF TWO COMMEMORATIVE COVERS. ONE WILL FEATURE THE "PREPARATION FOR DISCOVERY" LOGO BY EDNA H. MULLEN AND THE SECOND COVER AND CANCELLATION IS FROM A DRAWING BY DR. PAUL RIPPLE. THE COVERS ARE AVAILABLE AT LANCOPEX OR BY MAIL.
