

Millersville University - 150th Anniversary


The Lancaster County Normal Institute was established on April 17, 1855 in Millersville, Pa., a town of less than 100 residents. On November 18, 1855 the name was changed to Lancaster County Normal School. Marietta, Mount Joy and Hinkletown also had established normal schools in Lancaster County.

Old Main stood on the corner of what is now Frederick and George Streets and was replaced over a century later with the current library.

On July 7, 1927 the normal school was renamed Millersville State Teachers College and continued until November 12, 1982 when it became Millersville University as did the other state colleges in Pennsylvania.

The cachet for the Lancopex cover is from the corner card of a 1858 letter mailed from The Lancaster County Normal Institute. The actual cover can be viewed in the show exhibit "A Glimpse at Lancaster County Postal History".

"You want to store ALL the frames in whose garage?"


"You cut your winter hibernation in Florida short to attend OUR stamp show?" ...
