

BOY SCOUTS OF AMERICA 100TH ANNIVERSARY

In 1909, William D. Boyce, an American newspaperman and entrepreneur, became lost in London and was rescued by a Scout. The Scout declined a tip, saying he was doing his Good Turn as a Scout. Intrigued, Boyce visited Scouting headquarters to learn more about the program. On February 8, 1910, Boyce filed incorporation papers in Washington, D.C., and the Boy Scouts of America was born. Boyce enlisted the help of Ernest Thompson Seton and Daniel Carter Beard—both of whom had founded their own boys' organizations—to create an Americanized Scouting program. That program, described in the 1911 Handbook for Boy, was quickly adopted by young people across America.

For 100 years, the BSA has created a foundation of leadership, service, and community for millions of America's youth.




