## Stamp Tips

Kenya Republic - 1964 5-value set is getting scarce. Set is selling for \$7.20 mint and \$9.60 used in London.

United States - Scott #C7-9, air mail map issues of 1926-27 (plate blocks) are selling for \$25.00 and rising!

Central Lithuania - Scott #13-22, surcharged, is extremely rare.

East Germany - German patriots mint set, Scott #180-185, is in great demand by dealers in the D.D.R.

Hong Kong - The Queen Elizabeth set of 1962, Scott #203-217, with watermark upright has a good chance of price increase.

Trelend - Stamp prices have leveled. Now is the time to buy scarce issues before prices rise again. Scott #92, coil stamp issued in 1934, is scarce.

Lebenon - Quite rere is the set of 1948 Postal Tax stamps, Scott #RA 3-7.

Palestine - Scott #79, issued in 1927, is rising in price.

New Zealand - Queen Elizabeth II set issued in 1953-1957, Scott #288-301, is in great demand. .


Cenel Zone - Panama 1924 set, Scott #68-69, surcharged "Canal Zone" is in demand by collectors.

Congo - Red Cross issue of 1918, Scott #81-9, is almost exhausted.

Fernando Po - 1960 sculpture of Virgin Mary issue, Scott #181-189, is becoming scarce.
