THE LANCASTER LOCOMOTIVE WORKS-A HISTORIC LANCASTER INDUSTRY

THE LANCASTER ENGINE MACHINE MANUFACTURING COMPANY WAS ESTABLISHED MAY 30, 1853 BY A GROUP OF LOCAL INVESTORS. COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE LANCASTER LOCOMOTIVE WORKS, IT WAS LOCATED EAST OF ANN STREET AND FRONTED ON WALNUT STREET ALONG WHICH THE COLUMBIA & PHILADELPHIA RAILROAD TRACKS WERE LOCATED. THE GOAL WAS TO BUILD LOCOMOTIVES, STEAM ENGINES AND PRODUCE METAL CASTINGS. IN 1854 JOHN BRANDT SR., A LANCASTER NATIVE AND DISTINGUISHED LOCOMOTIVE BUILDER AND MECHANIC, JOINED THE COMPANY AS SUPERINTENDENT AND CHIEF ENGINEER.

THE COMPANY BUILT APPROXIMATELY ONE LOCOMOTIVE A MONTH. THE LANCASTER INTELLIGENCER REPORTED THAT THE COMPANY RECEIVED HIGH PRAISE FOR THE QUALITY OF THEIR ENGINES. MANY OF THE LOCOMOTIVES SUCH AS THE "JOHN C. BRECKENRIDGE" WERE MANUFACTURED FOR THE COLUMBIA & PHILADELPHIA RAILROAD.

THE BUSINESS DOWNTURN AND PANIC OF 1857 AND THE PURCHASE OF THE COLUMBIA & PHILADELPHIA RAILROAD BY THE PENNSYLVANIA RAILROAD WAS THE DEMISE OF THE LANCASTER LOCOMOTIVE WORKS IN OCTOBER 1857. SEVERAL ATTEMPTS BY OTHER COMPANIES INTO THE 1860'S TO PRODUCE LOCOMOTIVES AT THE SAME LOCATION WAS MET WITH LIMITED SUCCESS.

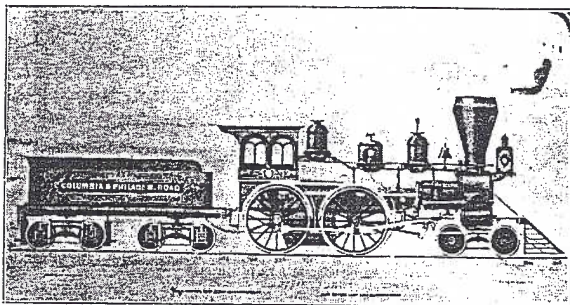

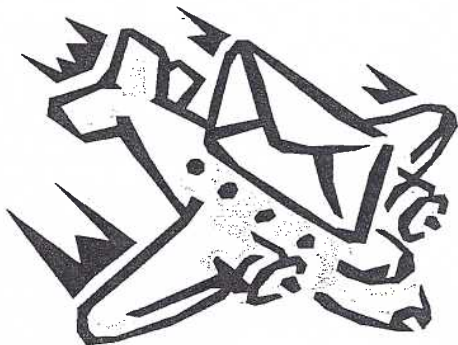

The company built at least one locomotive a month, many for the Cola. & Phila. RR. The business downturn and panic of 1857 caused the company to close thus ending

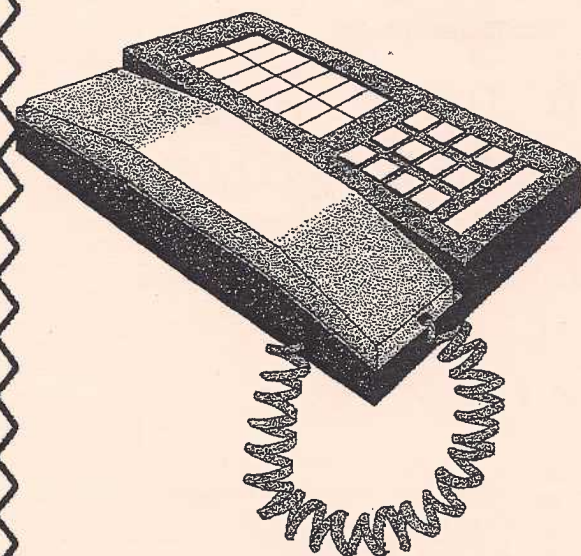
