You never know... ...what you could find!

The September 2012 issue of *The United States Specialist*, the club journal of the United States Stamp Society, gave a full report on a new color-omitted 41 cent flag coil stamp.

Of the five colors used to print this stamp, the light blue was totally absent, leaving off "41USA" from the design. You probably remember this series as a US flag on a beige background. By deduction, the articles confirms the stamp as 4188a.

Only two used examples have ever been found and they were sold as one lot on an internet auction site in December of 2008.

The stamps are on cover and appear to have been sent by the same person to the same address, although the return address was removed.

This probably means that the sender bought a coil roll of 100 at a local post office. Since about three weeks went by between mailings, it is probable that there were several, if not an entire roll of color omitted stamps.

No other examples have been found, and perhaps all the others were used and tossed. But perhaps not, or perhaps there were other rolls.

This is why it is so important to check every stamp you see or can look at. The article does not say what these stamps brought dollar-wise but I would guess that given no others were found, they would be worth even more.

This error will be listed in the 2013 Scott catalog as 4188c. The envelopes were mailed from the San Jose, CA, processing centers.
