
Julian Year March 25 to March 24 (Old Style) lost days due to misuse of leap years

Gregorian January 1 to December 31 (NS), proclaimed by Catholic Pope in 1582. Protestant England didn't accept the change.


Year dates between Jan 1 and March 23 appear 1711/12 OS/NS, gradually ending in America by about 1754.



Fort Albany August 1, 1675




Harrington Pennsylvania, later Delaware, April 1687








24 grs = 1 Pennyweight (Dwt) = 3 pence Ster.




Surrey Street London 15 May 1747



John Moultrie, Lieut. Governor of East Florida, ceded to Britain as part of Seven Year's War with West Florida, effective administrator, brothers William, James, Thomas and Alexander were famous Patriots. Daughter married Capt John Bligh. Double weight letter, rare Florida mail.



Georgia Gazette, May 2, 1765 "Schooner from Jamaica, Alex Mills, Master, to be quarantined on the Tybee River for 10 days, all mail has been recovered"






Pigg Point (near Upper Marlborough) March 7, 1775











Talbot Court House July 8, 1775




Barbadoes September 6, 1775




