Membership information may be obtained at the Courtesy Table or by mail to Lancaster County Philatelic Society, P.O. Box 982, Lancaster, PA 17603.

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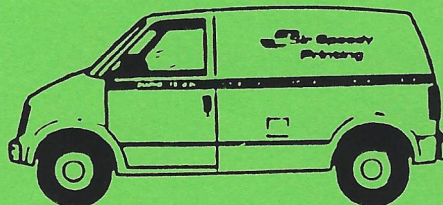
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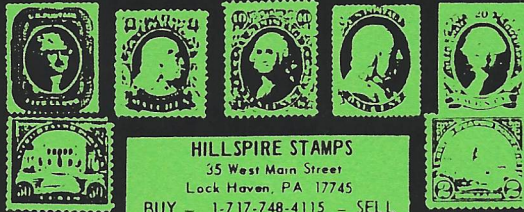

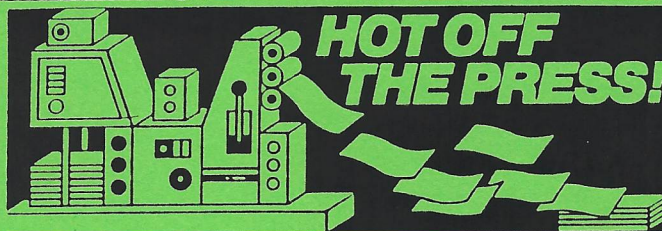

James Buchanan

James Buchanan, the 15th President of the United States was born April 23, 1791 at Stony Batter, Franklin County, PA. He attended school in Mercersburg, PA and graduated from Dickinson College in 1809. He moved to Lancaster that year to study law. He was admitted to the bar in 1812. A brief military career consisted of volunteering with a company for the defense of Baltimore in the War of 1812. It was at this time that his fiancée, Miss Anne Coleman, died. Buchanan remained a bachelor for the rest of his life earning him the distinction of being the only bachelor President.

In 1820 he was elected to the U.S. House of Representatives as a Federalist, where he served for 10 years. In 1834 he was elected to the U.S. Senate until 1845. Buchanan became the leader of the Pennsylvania Democratic Party and was appointed Secretary of State under President Polk from 1845-1849. During this period about one-third of our present territory was acquired. In 1852 Buchanan was nominated for president but was defeated on the 49th ballot by Franklin Pierce. In 1853 Pierce named him Minister to England. His nomination and election in 1856 as the 15th President of the United States was a compromise attempt to keep the Union together.

A strict constitutionalist, Buchanan was of the opinion that although slavery was a bad institution, the federal government had no legal right to interfere in it. He believed each state should decide to be slave or free. His administration was marred by a hostile Congress, regional rivalry and emotionalism. His efforts to divert attention to other domestic issues were in vain and by the end of his term it was evident that compromise was not possible. On March 4, 1861 James Buchanan turned the Presidency over to Abraham Lincoln and he retired to his Lancaster home "Wheatland" where he resided until his death, June 1, 1868.

History has not been kind to James Buchanan's efforts to maintain peace through compromise and the Constitution; but, as one author noted, "James Buchanan, the strict constitutionalist, could hardly have acted otherwise . . . He was a man of high character, unimpeachable honesty, patriotism and considerable ability."

James Buchanan is buried in Woodward Hill Cemetery, Lancaster, PA.

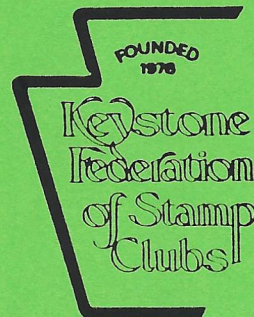
