Lancaster County Postcard Club Membership Distribution

July 31, 1999

We are nine years and seven months old at this writing. As a member of LCPC you can be quite proud of your club's growth in this short time. Our members total 312 and live in 234 households from coast to coast with an obvious concentration near Lancaster, PA.

There are 144 women and girls (46%) and 161 men and boys (54%) in our group. Sixty-six (21%) have a Lancaster City mailing address (although many live far into the 'burbs'). The county locals, 113, make up 36%; other residents of PA comprise 23% and our friends from other states (Maine to Florida to Washington) now make up 20% of our membership. A more detailed breakdown follows.

Lancaster County Postcard Club

Founded January 1990

Our club meets at the Farm and Home Center, near Routes #30 and #72. on Arcadia Road, Lancaster, PA. From Route #72, Manheim Pike, enter between Conestoga Marine and Jones Honda. We meet the third Monday of each month with the exception of the summer picnic and Christmas party. These events and locations are announced several months prior to the occasions.

Member set up to buy, sell and trade at 5:30 PM. The business meeting begins at 7 PM followed by monthly exhibit competition and the program. Programs might be slide or opaque projection presentation by a member, multiple-member participation, auctions, etc. until about 9 PM. We generally have 65 to 75 members at the monthly meetings. Books may be checked out from the library and returned on a 30-day basis at the meetings. It's best to phone our librarian so you can be sure the book you want will be available since we haven't the room, presently, to keep the entire library in the meeting room.

LCPC issues its own postcard each year for exchange during National Postcard Week (NPW) the first full week of May. Remaining back issues are often available at the club table, along with any other postcards LCPC has issued.

Each month **THE CARD**, an 8-page heavily illustrated bulletin is published by the club. It concentrates on postcards with equal emphasis on education and entertainment and, of course, recent events involving our club. Many members belong to LCPC for **THE CARD** even though they can't participate actively in the meetings.

The third Saturday of August has been our annual Expo day at the Farm and Home Center since 1993. It's a show with approximately 25 dealers selling postcards, plus a fine group of members' postcards exhibited for competition. In other words, unlike many postcard shows, ours is an exposition where postcards are exhibited as well as available for purchase. We gave it that name at our first show in 1993 - to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Columbian Exposition and the 60th anniversary of the Chicago Exposition. Good food made by club members is available.

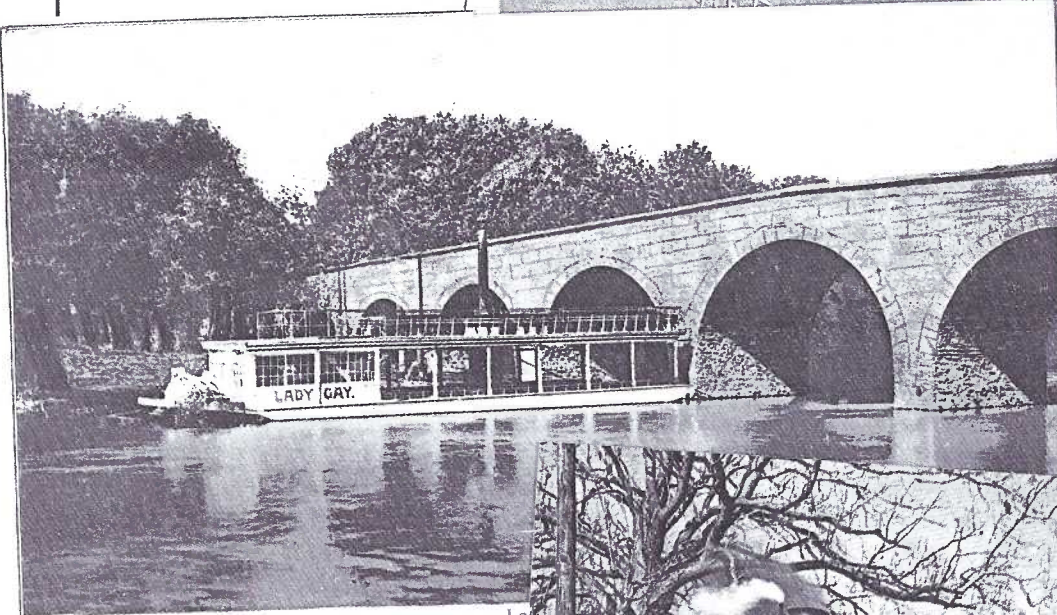
In 1998, LCPC became the first (as far as we can determine) postcard club to publish a deluxe hardcover volume of local views. It was the culmination of more than a year's intensive work. The book, Windows to Our Past, contains 500 cards and brief descriptions. 46 members contributed views. Only 2,000 books were printed.

Our membership year begins April 1 and concludes March 31. Dues for April 1999 to March 2000 are \$8 per member plus \$2 each additional member at the same address, with one issue of **THE CARD** going to each address as well as one copy of the membership roster. Persons joining during the year may write to the club to determine how much their first year's dues will be. If you know of a prospective member, have them drop a request to the club's address for a complimentary copy of **THE CARD** and a membership application.
