Minnesota Territory - 3¢ Blue Green issue date March 3, 1949. This stamp was issued to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the establishment of the Minnesota Territory.







Washington and Lee University - 3¢ Ultramarine issue date April 12, 1949. This issue commemorates the 200th anniversary of the founding of the Washington and Lee University at Lexington, Virginia.







Puerto Rico Election - 3¢ Green issue date April 27, 1949. To commemorate the first gubernatorial election in the territory of Puerto Rico. Pictured is a Puerto Rican farmer holding a cogwheel and ballot box.







Annapolis, Maryland Tercentenary - 3¢ Aquamarine issue date May 23, 1949. This stamp was issued to commemorate the 300th anniversary of the founding of the city of Annapolis in Maryland.



Edgar Allan Poe - 3¢ Bright red violet, issue date October 7, 1949. This stamp was issued in remembrance of the 100th anniversary of the death of the Boston born poet and story writer Edgar Allan Poe.











Grand Army of the Republic - 3¢ Bright Rose Carmine issue date August 29, 1949. This stamp was issued to commemorate the final national encampment of the Grand Army of the Republic in Indianapolis, Indiana from August 28 to September 1, 1949

<u>DC-4 Skymaster - 6¢ Carmine issue date January 18,1949.</u> This stamp was issued to conform to the increase of the airmail postage rate from 5¢ to 6¢. There were two processes used in the printing of this stamp the "Dry" and "Wet" methods.









Alexandria, Virginia Bicentennial - 6¢ Carmine issue date May 11, 1949. Commemorates the 200th anniversary of the founding of Alexandria, Virginia. The stamp design illustrates the home of John Carlyle (city founder) and Gadsby's Tavern a one-time meeting place frequented by George Washington and John Paul Jones.







DC-4 Skymaster - 6¢ Carmine issue date August 25,1949. This stamp was issued in a coil format.







75th Anniversary of the Universal Postal Union Centenary - 15¢ Light Blue Issue date October 7, 1949. This the second stamp honoring the formation of the Universal Postal Union which was founded as an independent international agency and whose headquarters is in Byrne, Switzerland









<u>DC-4 Skymaster - 6¢ Carmine Booklet issue date November 18, 1949.</u> This was the first time this stamp was issued in a booklet format. There were two processes used in the printing of this stamp the "Dry" and "Wet" methods.









75th Anniversary of the Universal Postal Union Centenary - 10¢ Violet stamp issue date November 18, 1949. This is the first in a series of three issues celebrating the 75th anniversary of the formation of the Universal postal union. The design features the Post Office Department Building.







75th Anniversary of the Universal Postal Union Centenary - 25¢ Rose Carmine stamp issue date November 30, 1949. This is the third in a series of three issues celebrating the 75th anniversary of the formation of the Universal Postal Union. This Postal Union is presently a specialized agency of the United Nations and is dedicated to improving international postal services.







Wright Brothers - 6¢ Magenta stamp issue date December 17, 1949.

Commemorates the 46th anniversary of the first successful fight of a heavier-than-air powered aircraft. The flight took place on December 17, 1903 at 10:30 a.m. at Kitty Hawk, North Carolina.
