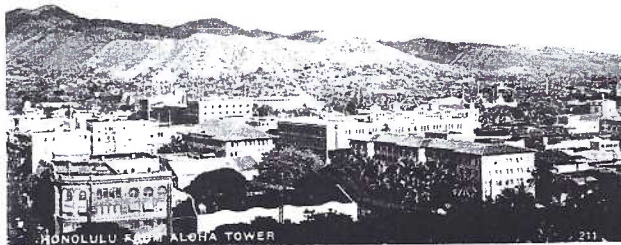

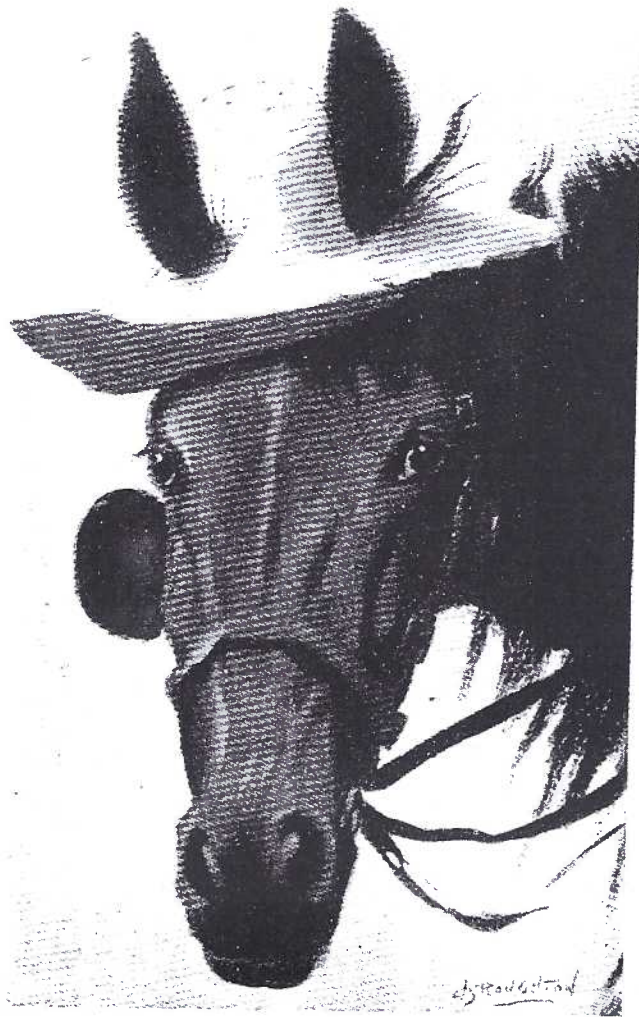
The March 15, 2010 Lancaster County (Pennsylvania) Postcard Club Meeting by Doug Milliken, president

To Forget the Mistakes of the Past and Press On to the Greater Achievements of the Future

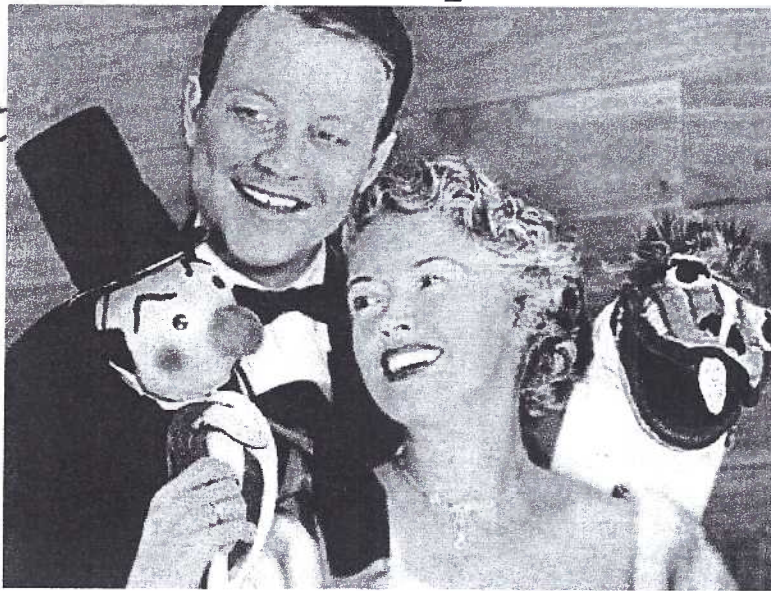

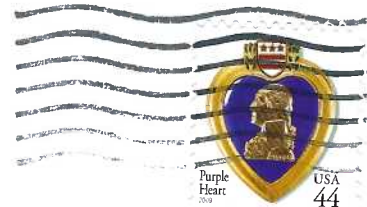
