
Our monthly Publication, *The Card*, includes club news, local postcard history and articles covering postcard collecting in general. Ask for a complimentary copy

### The only postcard club published books of their kind.


In 1998 our club published a hard cover deluxe edition book of 500 local postcard views with descriptions and values. *Windows to Our Past*, we've learned, is the first book of its size and substance to be published by a postcard club. The edition of 2,000 copies is sold out. Copies are now selling at a premium.

Last year LCPC took up the venture once more. Windows to Our Past, Volume Two, made its debut at our 2002 Expo. It includes 520 different views from Volume One and we increased the color plates from 49 to 109 while holding the price at \$30! As much sought after as Volume One is, you might consider getting your extra copies of Volume Two today. Relatives and friends who've moved from Lancaster will certainly enjoy the nostalgia conjured up by these old postcard views. The books make wonderful gifts.
