



**Description of front cover postcards:** *Left* - Seasons Greetings is a retro view from the 1950s. It was published by Coca Cola in 1991 to promote gifts at K-Mart Photo Centers. *Right* - On a postal card (1914 printed stamp) a free case of drinks was offered by the Dr. Pepper Bottling Co. *Lower right* - An over-size PC, printed by International Harvester Co., features a Coca Cola delivery truck in the late 1930s. **Back cover:** *Left* - Home of Pepsi-Cola at New Berne, NC "built by us for our own use." In 1909 it was the "largest plant of its kind in the world, covering 4 acres." *Right* - A postal card served as a Pepsi Pigskin Payoff entry for football fans in the 1980s (13¢ stamp). *Lower left* - Chas. S. Scholl, "Manufacturer of Soft Drinks" gave his retailers this 1¢ postal for easy ordering. *Lower right* - A second PC from Coke in their series promoting K-Mart's Kodak Photo Center in 1991.
