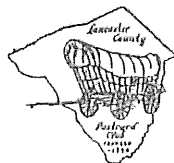

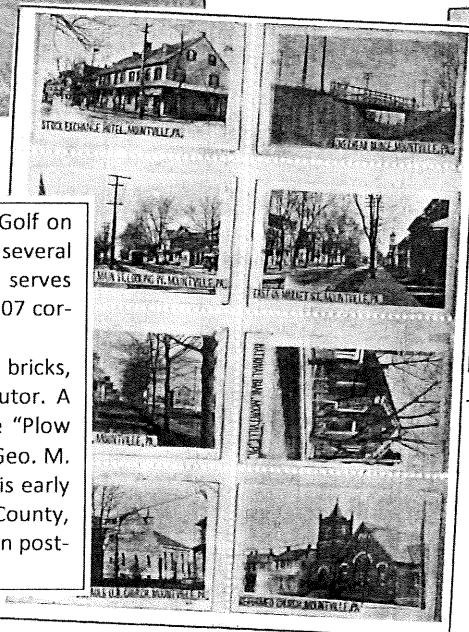

**Front cover cards** - Brader's Drive-In & Miniature Golf on the Lincoln Hwy. was a pioneer in its field. With several large additions, the town's 1901 public school still serves the Mountville community. The fire house has a 1907 cornerstone.

**Back cover cards** - Lancaster County was built with bricks, and Mountville's brick plant was a major contributor. A work crew relaxes at the Mountville Mfg. Co.; the "Plow Works" later became part of Sperry New Holland. Geo. M. Drumm proudly shows his Meat Market team in this early real photo view. A unique feature in Lancaster County, these postage stamp size views could be mounted on post-cards made specifically for their use.
