January 13, 2007 – Hershey, PA – The 100 Anniversary of Hershey's Kisses was celebrated with U.S. Post Service issuing Scott #4122 stamp and #4122a Love Hershey Kisses booklet stamps. These 39¢ stamps evoked images of sweet affection with the stamp featuring a Hershey's® Kisses Brand Chocolate and a Red Heart that form images of one another.
