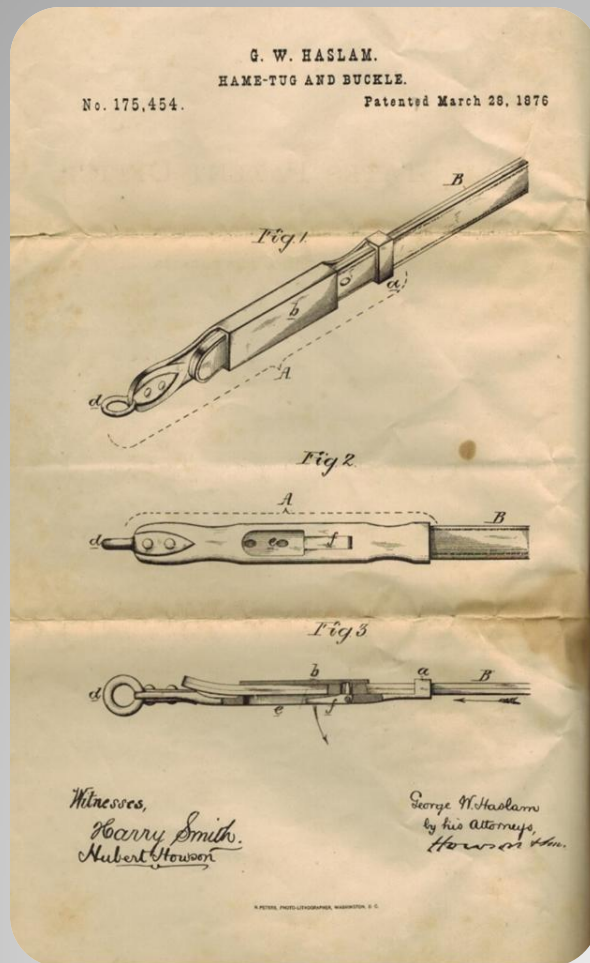
## Tug and Buckle

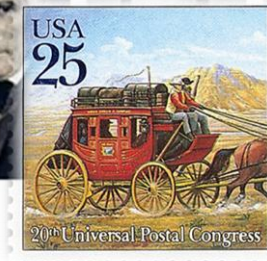

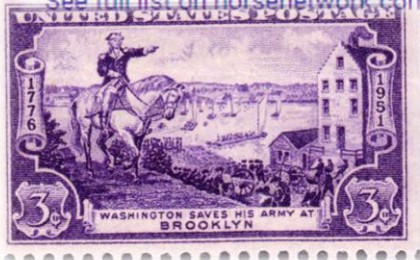

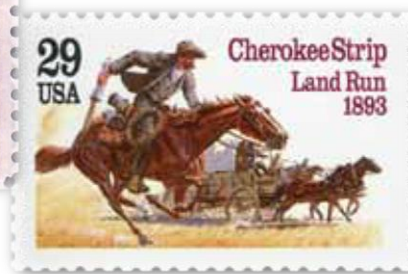
